Show Rules:

1. This show is sanctioned by ADGA. ADGA rules shall govern.
2. The Junior and Senior Doe shows are sanctioned separately. The Senior Show is sanctioned for Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Saanen, AOP, and Recorded Grade. The Junior Show is sanctioned for Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, AOP and Recorded Grade. This will be the show order. The show order is subject to change so the show will run more smoothly.
3. Showmanship will begin promptly at 10 am, followed by the Junior Show doe. Costume Class will begin at 4pm, followed by Adult Showmanship, and then the Senior Doe Show.
4. Entries postmarked by June 30th are \$6 per doe. Entries postmarked after June 30th will be \$10 per doe. **Absolutely NO entries will be accepted after July 9th.** There is no fee for showmanship or costume class.
5. Checks should be made out to: Nicholas County Fair Association. Fees must accompany entry form. No refunds for any reason.
6. Substitutes for scratched animals will be accepted until 9am on show day.
7. Straw or chips will be available at market cost. Please indicate on entry form how much you will need. All bedding must be removed at the end of the show by the exhibitor and placed in designated area.
8. No horned animals allowed.
9. The base date for determining age will be the date of the show. The original registration certificate (required for animals 6 months or older) or stamped duplicate must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show.
10. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious disease will not be allowed on the grounds. Show Committee will check animals and their decision is final. Out of state animals are required to have a health certificate issued within 30 days of the show. WV animals do not need health certificates, but must have Honor Flock certificate.
11. Animals may arrive on Thursday after 5pm. All animals must be in place and checked in with the show secretary by 9:30am Friday.
12. The Nicholas County Fair Association will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to persons, animals or property. Exhibitors are responsible for their children and animals.
13. No alcoholic beverages permitted on the fairgrounds.
14. No dogs permitted in the barns or show arena.

15. Inhumane treatment of animals will not be tolerated.
16. Failure to comply with rules of the show or fairgrounds may result in exhibitor/agent being barred from this and/or future shows. No refund of fees.
17. Camper parking without electric or sewage hookup is available.
18. Raffle tickets will be sold throughout the show at ring side. Drawings will be held after the finish of the Senior Doe Show. If you would like to make a donation to our raffle to help support the show, please contact Marilyn Grossman at kickadeehill@aol.com or call 304-539-3148.
