Rules:

1. You may pre-register your animal through July 3, 2014. Registration forms are available online at <http://nicholas.ext.wvu.edu>, at Nicholas Co. Ext. Office, 715 Main St. Summersville, or All Creatures Pet Store, 3019 Webster Rd., Summersville. Pre-registration is not required, but very helpful.
2. WV farm animals ONLY. No out-of-state animals will be accepted.
3. Your animal need not be pedigreed.
4. All animals must be healthy! Lambs and goats must have current "Honor Flock" Certificate. Equine must have a negative Coggin's Test (from a USDA official approved laboratory) within the last 12 months. We strongly recommend that all equine be rabies vaccinated. Show Committee will check animals upon arrival and their decision is final. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious disease will not be allowed on the grounds. Please bring a copy of certificate, shots, etc.
5. Poultry, Fowls, Rabbits, and Pigs must be in an Exhibition Cage. Pigs, Goats, Lambs, and Equine need to be in halter and will be lead around the show ring. Animals must be restricted and kept under control at all times.
6. Animals should arrive on Tuesday after 4:00 pm and will be released at the end of the show.
7. The Nicholas County Fair Association will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to persons, animals, or property. Exhibitors are responsible for their children and animals.
8. No Alcoholic beverages permitted on the fairgrounds.
9. No dogs permitted in the barn or show area.
10. Inhuman treatment of animals will not be tolerated.
